For the review, the extended abstracts in MS-WORD or PDF file should be submitted to the ICACT 2007 conference website (<http://www.icact.org>), filling the every item and uploading the respective extended abstract.

After you win the acceptance notification, you will prepare the final camera-ready manuscript of maximum six(6) IEEE double-column formatted pages, the Copyright Transfer Agreement, and the Speaker's Biography together.
