All the manuscripts must be written in English and should be prepared in given style by ICACT bureau. All submitted full papers or extended summaries will be reviewed by the technical program committee. For the review, all the papers in PDF should be submitted to the ICACT2010 conference website (www.icact.org), filling every item and uploading the respective papers.

After you win the acceptance notification, you have to prepare the final camera-ready manuscript of maximum six(6) IEEE double-column formatted pages, the Copyright Transfer Agreement, and the Speaker's Biography together.
